Adjectives in Spanish – Adjective "Agreement"

What is an adjective? A DESCRIBING WORD

In Spanish, adjectives go **AFTER** the word they describe.

Example: <u>la camisa</u> <u>roja</u> = the red shirt

(the shirt) (red)

2 RULES ABOUT ADJECTIVES - MAKE THEM "AGREE"!

Adjectives that end in "o" or "a" must **MATCH** the word they describe – look at the END LETTER or the ARTICLE.

Example: la camisa amarilla = the yellow shirt

el traje **blanco** = the white suit

Adjectives that are describing a **PLURAL** thing must end in the letter "s"

Example: las camisas amarillas = the yellow shirts

los trajes blancos = the white suits

*For adjectives that end in a *consonant*, you add "es"

Example: azul – azules marrón – marrones

verde – verd**es** gris – gris**es**
