

Adjectives in Spanish – Adjective “Agreement”

What is an adjective? **A DESCRIBING WORD**

In Spanish, adjectives go **AFTER** the word they describe.

Example: la camisa roja = the red shirt
(the shirt) (red)

2 RULES ABOUT ADJECTIVES – MAKE THEM “AGREE”!

Adjectives that end in “o” or “a” must **MATCH** the word they describe – look at the END LETTER or the ARTICLE.

Example: la camisa amarilla = the yellow shirt
el traje blanco = the white suit

Adjectives that are describing a **PLURAL** thing must end in the letter “s”

Example: las camisas amarillas = the yellow shirts
los trajes blancos = the white suits

*For adjectives that end in a **consonant**, you add “es”

Example: azul – azules marrón – marrones
verde – verdes gris – grises
